

inhus Planning:



Order to completion within 4 weeks without *planning permission.

Planning information

The inhus garden office range doesn't require planning permission, in 95% of cases.

Garden buildings are classed as sectional buildings and are not a permanent structure.

*There are circumstances when your local planning office needs to be consulted:

- If you intend to locate your inhus within 5 metres of your house.
- If your inhus takes up more than 50% percent of your garden area.
- If you live in a building that is listed or within a Conservation area.
- If your home is in a National Park, an area of outstanding national beauty.
- If the position of your inhus garden building is between the highway and your property.
- If you cannot position your inhus garden building 1 metre from any garden boundary.
- If your inhus is not for residential private use.

You will need to apply for planning if the garden building is larger in floor area than 30 square metres

Inhus can be supplied up to 30 square metres in size without planning permission.

I have tight access, can you help?



London installation.

A normal London installation includes, endless traffic and countless parking problems. We unfortunately cannot change this, however, we still started at 7am. every morning.

Access.

This is the access we installed a inhus 51-38 model and every wall window, roof panel went through this small gateway.



90 degrees turn.

At the end of the alley we had to up end all of the panels, turn the panel 90 degrees and then lay them back down, then carry them 1400 yards, felt like 800 yards.

Rear site Access.

We have arrived, to find we only have a 900mm gap to load up the garden and carry out the build.



"Lovely" a small garden.

We love small gardens, however with the site access problems, we decided to off load the whole build into the garden, so that we didn't have to bring the trailer back to London.

Finished.
